UK Working Holiday Visa Age Increase

The recent announcement of an age increase for Australia's working holiday visa has gained substantial media attention in the UK. With over 35,000 young Brits venturing to Australia annually on this visa, the expansion of the age range from 30 to 35 years aims to attract even more UK travellers. Tourism Australia's team in the UK has been successful in securing coverage across various media platforms, including BBC News TV, with over 350 pieces of coverage highlighting the allure of a working holiday down under. Additionally, starting from July 2024, UK passport holders will be eligible for a three-year working holiday visa without specific work requirements, further enhancing mobility options for young UK travellers. These efforts are expected to support Australia's tourism sector recovery by encouraging more young British individuals to explore work and leisure opportunities in the country.
